PBIS is a framework that is in its fifth year of implementation in the Westfield Public School system. PBIS stands for Positive Behavior Intervention Support. It is comprised of research-based behavioral practices and interventions that have been shown to improve social behaviors and academic achievement.

- A=academic achievement**
